Malaysian Interventional Pulmonology Course

Course description

The Department of Respiratory Medicine, Queen Elizabeth Hospital is hosting this course in collaboration with Arizona Pulmonary Specialist Group, USA. The goal of this course is to educate respiratory physicians and trainees on the principles and practice of interventional pulmonology.

The course will focus on common pleural and tracheo-bronchial diseases. There will be 4 live video procedures on the second day.

The third day will be devoted to workshop activities designed to provide participants in small groups with hands-on training.

A local faculty and an international faculty will combine their experience and share their insight and skills with participants.

Several manufacturers of pleuroscope, rigid bronchoscopes, laser, stents, EBUS and autofluorescence bronchoscope will be making their products available for evaluation and use during workshops. After completing this course, participants should have:

- A working knowledge of fundamentals of interventional pulmonology,
- A basic understanding of indications and contraindications,
- Hands-on experience in rigid intubation, laser and stenting,
- A theoretical approach on the diagnostic techniques
